What about funding?

- If you are not funded, you will be able to apply for an advanced learner loan to cover tuition fees.
- We will guide you in how to apply for this and what evidence you will need to support your loan application.
- This is added onto your loans at university and treated the same as any other student loan.
- Once you complete your degree, the loan for Access diploma fees is written off.





What about applying to university?

- You will receive support throughout the course from your tutor and from the information and guidance team.
- We can assist you in writing your application and personal statement and we will provide an academic reference for you.





How to apply for the Access to HE diploma

- Apply though the Weymouth College website.
- We will then contact you to arrange interviews and / or assessments.
- During your interview, you will receive further advice on the diploma you have selected and you will be able to meet a member of the Access team.
