**SELECTION** By interview minimum entry requirements 3 GCSE's at Level 3 or equivalent including English and Science.

**COURSE CONTENT**

This qualification introduces you to practical Beauty Therapy skills. It provides you with the foundation for further learning and progression pathways within the Beauty Therapy framework or other chosen pathway.

**PROGRESSION**

## SELECTION

You will have an interview with your Tutor, be expected to successfully complete a trade test and pass a theory test reaching a minimum of a merit grade. We expect our learners to maintain the high standards set out in Level 2 and continue with their personal development. As part of your course you will be expected to carry out five external work experience days which must be Industry based.

- How do I apply for a course?
