You will need a GCSE grade 4 or C in English and Maths

Occasionally we will accept a 3 or D in one of the subjects

In this is the case, you will be required to study English or Maths GCSE until you have achieved a 4 or C in both subjects.

(Candidates that do not meet the entry requirements will be offered the Construction Skills course with direct progression to level 1 Carpentry & Joinery next year)
