The Level 1 'Diploma in Plumbing Studies' is aimed at learners with little or no plumbing experience or knowledge,



who are interested in pursuing a career in the Plumbing industry.

The course is a mixture of Plumbing practical training and assessment alongside Plumbing theory lessons with end of unit 'knowledge assessments'.

- Tasks such as: soldering, accurate measuring and cutting, using different materials and tools, small scale plumbing installations (basin, radiator etc)
