#### **Extended Diploma in Public Services**

This qualification has been developed to meet the needs of a broad spectrum of public service areas from uniformed roles in defence, emergency, security and justice, to non-uniformed roles in central and local government, as well as related voluntary and private sector agencies.

You will gain a wide range of transferable skills needed for public service employment and have the opportunity to be involved in taster sessions, trips and visits. There will also be a programme of industry speakers. You will gain the knowledge, understanding and skills required for success in current and future employment, or for progression to courses such as BTEC Higher Nationals, Foundation degrees or Honours degrees.



#### **Frequently Asked Questions**

- How many days a week will I be at college?
  - Approximately 3 days a week in college and two independent study/industry experience days.
- Will I have to purchase a college public services kit?
  - Yes, this is approximately £40 and will be discussed at enrolment.
- Will I have the opportunity to resit my GCSEs?
  - Yes, unless you already have English and Maths at Grade 4, GCSE retakes will be built into your timetable.
- What is college life like?
  - College is an adult learning environment. We will support you in all aspects of your learning, however as an adult learner we want you take responsibility for your learning. You will have to ensure you are organised and adhere to all assessment deadlines.
- Will my attendance and punctuality be monitored?
  - Yes the sport and public services department instil the highest regards for attendance and punctuality as this is required in the workplace.
  - Your tutor will monitor your attendance weekly.
- Can I access extra help at college?
  - Yes, speak with your tutor at enrolment, induction or throughout any part of your course to gain extra help.
