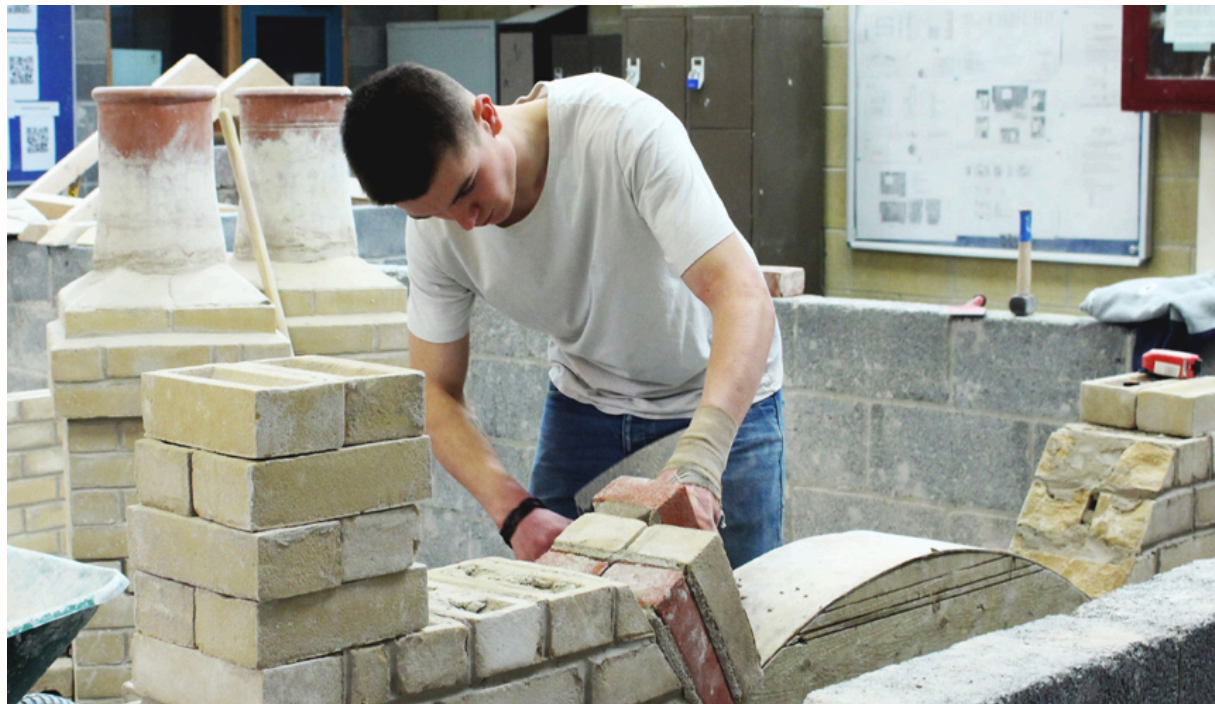


Trowel Occupations Level 1 Diploma

The level 1 Diploma qualification is for candidates who want to work as a Bricklayer in the Construction sector

Entry Requirements

You will need a GCSE grade 4 or C in English and Maths. Occasionally we will accept a grade 3 or D in one of the subjects*

Or

Completion of Construction Skills Course

Or

Prior experience in the construction industry

**If this is the case, you will be required to study English or Maths GCSE until you have achieved a 4 or 4C in both subjects.*

(Candidates that do not meet the entry requirements will be offered the Construction Skills course with direct progression to level 1 Brickwork next year)
