

The courses within the Art and Design department aim to enable you to succeed within the Creative Arts industry, or to progress to higher education.

On our Art and Design courses you will develop skills across a range of digital and traditional media including sculpture, painting, drawing, Adobe suite, photography, textiles and printmaking aswell as considering your options for progression and career development.

You will also initiate research ideas, develop and explore those ideas and take to resolved outcomes.



What are the course entry requirements?

Level 2 UAL Diploma in Art and Design

You will be expected to have achieved 4 GCSE's at grades 1-3 including an art based subject and English language or equivalent, or other related level 1 qualification.

Level 3 UAL diploma in Art and Design/ Photography

You will be expected to have achieved 5 GCSEs at grade 4 or above including art or photography, English language or equivalent and Maths. We will also accept a BTEC First Diploma or other related level 2 qualification at Merit or higher

You will be required to bring a portfolio of work to interview.



What will you expect from me?

To Achieve a full qualification to the highest standard we ask for: A high level of attendance Punctuality and meeting deadlines Commitment to the course and respect for colleagues and staff A drive and self discipline suitable for your level of course Independant study Engagemnet in visits, experiences, opportunities and shows

Work Experience and organised study trips

We offer a range of experoiences across the department including an international residential. Alongside this we run a programme of Visiting artists from a wide range of breadth of backgrounds and disciplines.

Students are encouraged to engage in external activities such as competitions, community projects and volunteering opportunities such as those through B-Side festival.

The academic year cumulates in a showcase of work from across the courses which is open to the public.

Progression Routes
