What is female genital mutilation?

Female genital mutilation (sometimes referred to as female circumcision) refers to procedures that intentionally alter or cause injury to the female genital organs for non-medical reasons. The practice is illegal in the UK. It is also illegal to arrange for a young person to be taken abroad for female genital mutilation.
