## **Covid-19 Testing:**

The government have requested that colleges resume the Covid-19 testing facility through to the end of September. You will be offered the opportunity to be tested twice on site on your return, however, if you would prefer you will be able to request a home lateral flow test kit to complete testing at home. Information on how to book on site testing, and/or request a home test kit, will be sent out to you prior to the start of term.

In terms of other precautions

- You will no longer be required to wear a face mask, however, you of course, can continue to wear a mask if you wish.
- You will no longer be required to social in bubbles.
- We will not prevent anyone who wishes to wear a mask from doing so, however in the classroom we recommend face coverings are not worn by teaching staff to facilitate communication
- We will continue to recommend use of hand sanitiser and good hygiene practice
- Rooms should continue to be well ventilated
