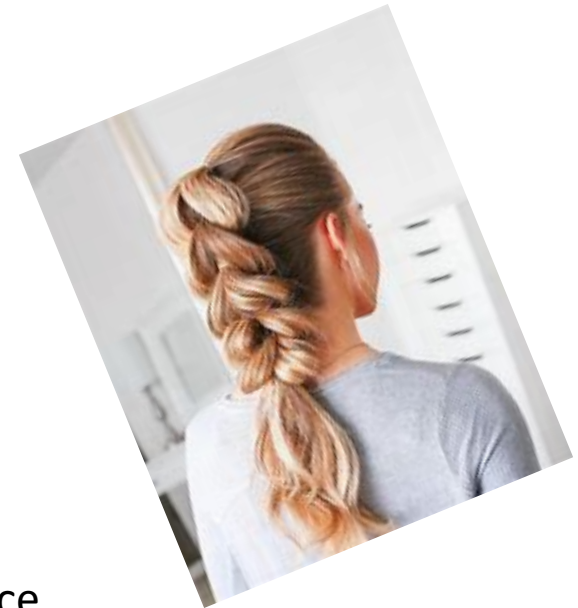

You will complete an additional qualification alongside- VTCT Skin Cancer awareness

Apprenticeship

An apprenticeship will continue to develop your skills and knowledge whilst working in the industry.

Frequently Asked Questions

How many days a week will I be at college?

Approximately 3 days a week

Will I have to purchase a college kit/uniform?

Approximate price- kit £380/uniform £30- this will be discussed & confirmed at interview

Will I have the opportunity to resit my GCSEs?

Yes, unless you already have English and Maths at Grade 4, GCSE retakes will be built into your timetable.

What is college life like?
